Requirements for Program Completion

Please review the requirements to successfully complete Evolving the Etheric Body: Supporting physical healing. Successful completion will yield a Certificate of Achievement and make you eligible to register for and attend, [Energetic Assessment: Determining Root Cause](#). While grading is not a factor in the program, it is important that you devote the time to the material and to your practice client sessions to be ready to integrate the Etheric practices into your paid client sessions.

Program Requirements

- Completion of all Lessons, Topics, Quizzes – these are delivered sequentially, so you are ‘forced’ through the knowledge acquisition process.
- Submission of all Practicum elements in their entirety, in appropriate, approved formats for review and feedback from EHI Practitioner-Instructors and/or Jill Leigh.
 - 24 hours of documented, in-person practice client sessions, 4 clients with 6 hours/client. – pdf
Note: Client cases with less than 3 sessions will not be accepted! There is no case progression to observe when there only a few sessions.
 - 6 hours of documented remote sessions, 2 clients, 3 hours/client – pdf
Note: Client cases with less than 3 sessions will not be accepted! There is no case progression to observe when there only a few sessions.
 - 1 videotaped in-person session, including all session elements and documentation - Case Intake, Creating an Intention, Treatment Strategy (Astral & Etheric), Session Notes, Skills Protocols - mp4, pdf
 - 1 videotaped Etheric Chelation

We further expect you to review the feedback that is provided from EHI and incorporate any suggestions we make into your learning. We are not interested in perfection nor are we adamant that you do everything ‘our way’. We are interested in quality and comprehension.
